









Math Glossary

Lessons 31-40

| Lsn | Term | Definition | Picture / Example |
|------|------------------------|--|---|
| 31 | *estimate | to guess the value or measurement based on given information |  |
| 31 | *ones' place | The digit farthest to the right in a whole number; or the only digit in a single-digit number | 73 <u>6</u> |
| 32 | *centimeter | a small metric unit used to measure length; cm | 100 centimeter = 1 meter  |
| 32 | *length | The distance from one end to the other end; the longer side of a rectangle |  |
| 35-2 | *number sentence | A sentence that uses numbers and symbols, but not words | $4 + 3 = 7$ |
| 39 | *minutes | a unit used to measure time; min. 60 minutes = 1 hour |  |
| 39 | *a.m. ante meridiem | the time of day starting at midnight and ending at noon; in Latin, ante meridiem means "before midday" |  |
| 39 | *p.m. post meridiem | the time of day starting at noon and ending at midnight; in Latin, post meridiem means "after midday" | |
| 40-2 | *bar graph | a graph that displays data using parallel rectangles, or bars, whose lengths are proportional to the quantities they represent |  |
| 40-2 | *pictograph | a graph that uses pictures or symbols to display information |  Each  stands for 2 votes. |
