











5th grade supply list

Basic/simple (non decorative) supplies are preferred as most of these items replenish the materials I use to begin the year. Tissue, sanitizer, pencils and glue sticks are communal supplies. I recommend students having their own art supplies (crayons, colored pencils, markers, scissors)
