



Dietary Information and Needs

Essentials:

- **Refillable water bottle**: Water stations are not always near our activities (such as on the hike). Our staff will make sure to stop at refill stations throughout the day.

-Shoes: Participants need to have closed toe shoes to participate in our activities.

A second pair of comfort shoes can be packed for cabin and mealtimes.

-Hat: Such as a ballcap or a beanie for cold weather.
