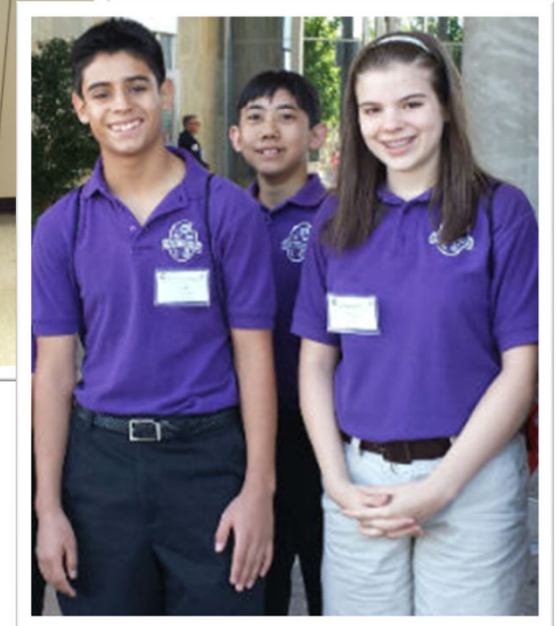


Knights Dress Code

Hair

Boys: Hair should be short, neat and not touching/covering ears or eyes, natural colors only

Girls: Hair should be a natural color, not covering eyes, non distracting

Uniform Shirts

Boys/Girls: ACP Crest uniform polo (White, Black, Gray, Purple), if undershirt is worn it must be non distracting school colors

- Correct size (*not baggy, not tight, not too short*), tucked in, clean



Shorts

Boys: Black or Khaki tailored dress style fit with no large baggy pockets

Girls: Black or Khaki with **minimum 8 inch inseam**, dress style, no designs or rips, not too tight

Skirts

Girls: Skirt must be approaching the knee no higher than 2 inches from the knee, solid Black, Navy, or Khaki or uniform plaid, not form fitting

Pants

Boys: Black, Navy, or Khaki color, dress style, no jean material, not tight fitting, no rips/holes, no sweatpants

Girls: Black, Navy, or Khaki color, dress style, no jean material, not tight fitting, NO leggings, jeggings, spandex, no embellishments or designs, no rips/holes, no sweatpants

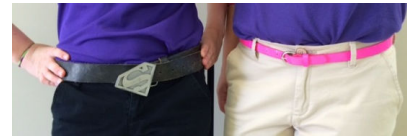
Belts

Boys/Girls: Black or Brown solid color leather type, no embellishments or designs, standard formal buckle, professional looking

Socks

Boys/Girls: Solid color (Black, White, Gray, Purple), no designs or embellishments, professional non-distracting, compliment to the outfit

Shoes

Boys: Complementary to uniform, non distracting

Girls: Complementary to uniform, sandals must have back strap, non distracting, no high heeled shoes

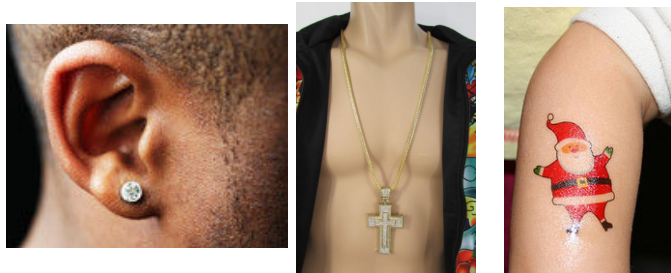
Accessories- Hats, Scarves, Jewelry

Boys: Hats, sunglasses, scarves in solid school color only (Black, Gray, Purple, White) to be worn *outside only*. One small necklace permitted. NO temporary tattoos.

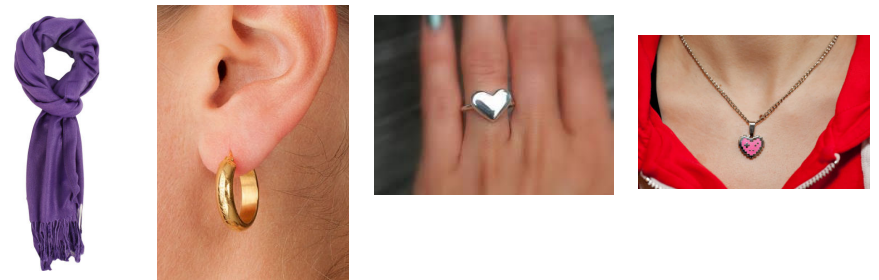

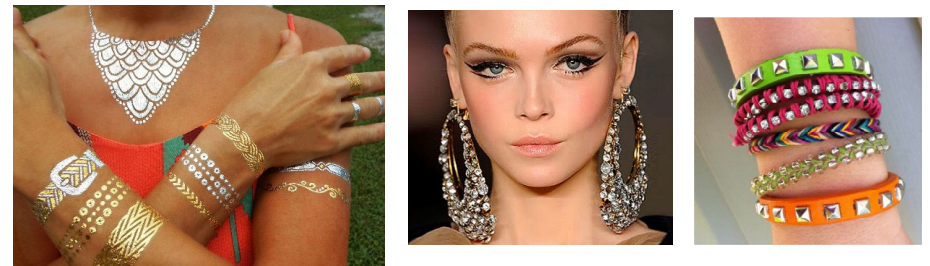


Girls: Hats, sunglasses, scarves in solid school color only (Black, Gray, Purple, White) to be worn *outside only*. One small necklace and bracelet permitted, one pair of small earrings, one ring per hand. NO temporary tattoos.

Sweatshirts/Jackets

Boys/Girls: ACP Logo sweatshirt or solid school color (Black, Purple, White, Gray) without logo or design. Zippered or pull over style, no stripes.

Friday Dress

Boys/Girls: Friday ACP logo shirt or ACP Club shirt with jeans, tucked in, belt optional. No jeggings or legging jeans, no rips or embellishments/designs. Jean shorts must have minimum 8 inch inseam. No club team shirts. College wear only on last Friday of the month
