Grade-Level Connection


- Grade-Level Coordinators will organize planning/practice sessions
- Make every effort to attend as you will be able to plan for your delivery, share ideas, gather supplies, and create the art project before heading into the classroom



Lesson Planning

Class Session Scheduling

- Schedule class sessions in advance with your teacher. <u>Ideally, schedule all six</u> <u>lessons now!</u> NOTE: Art to Remember must be complete by September 14th
- Do not overlap sessions during the same time with any other art sessions at your grade level and make every effort to not overlap with other grade levels

- Provide your planned dates/times to your grade level coordinator, who will update the calendar
 - Your grade-level lead will block 15 minutes ahead of your classroom time and 15 minutes after for setup/cleanup
 - Class sessions are typically planned for 60 minutes



- C. At the top right of the page, click on "sign in"

User name = fireAM

Password = Owen (case sensitive)

IMPORTANT: this is a shared username and password that we <u>all</u> will use. If the wrong password is entered 5 times, we're locked out for 30 minutes. Key carefully!

Rules of the Road

Classroom code of conduct

Let the students do a lot of the talking. This is as much about them using their imagination and inquisitive minds as it is about them learning facts about artists and artwork

Displaying artwork


- Be sure to display the art work outside the teachers room after each lesson is completed
- Artwork must be 18 inches off the ground and 18 inches down from the ceiling
- Nothing can be adhered to the colored bricks or within 18 inches of an outlet

Student Portfolios

- All art creations are to be kept in a student portfolio in the teacher's room once taken down from the displays
- Each class has portfolio covers. You only need to add the student's name.
- Portfolios should be completed and given to teacher by May 17th to avoid the year-end rush.

Supplies

- Grade-level specific supplies are in the workroom in a bin by grade level.
- Each classroom and each project has a folder within the grade-level bin.
- After classroom delivery, please return supplies in same condition for next class.





- Lesson One is the selected theme
- Specific paper is required and supplied
- Have student sign (or initial) and date the front of artwork at least 1" from the edge of the paper (somewhere within the artwork)
- If writing on the back of the art, use light pencil. Do not use marker or as it will show through the art!
- Occilect artwork, ensuring one for each student
- Adhere pre-printed labels with student name and class information in the upper left corner of the back of the artwork to indicate orientation
- Bundle completed (and dried) artwork together once ALL art is collected and place in provided bin in the workroom (northeast corner)

ALL FINISHED ART WORK MUST BE TURNED IN SEPTEMBER 14th!



Art to Remember Timeline

- Lessons must be complete no later than <u>September 14th</u>
 - Completed art work must be labeled and turned in no later than 3:00pm
- Teachers will distribute personalized order forms to students on October 17Th (Return from Fall Break)
- Parents place orders online no later than November 1ST
- Orders returned to Fulton and distributed to students in <u>December</u>, in time for the gift giving season!





Next Steps

- Define a grade level coordinator if not already defined.
- Get acquainted with other volunteers in your classroom and your grade-level coordinator
- Contact your teacher to schedule your six lessons and give that information to your grade-level coordinator so it can be added to the calendar
- Ensure that Art to Remember (lesson one) is completed and in the designated bin in the workroom by Friday, September 14th at 3:00pm.
- Confirm with your teacher where you can display artwork throughout the year
 - It is your responsibility to decorate and maintain the bulletin board throughout the school year
- Create your classroom portfolios and leave them with your teacher
 - File artwork throughout the year
