Lesson Planning

Class Session Scheduling

- Do not overlap sessions during the same time with any other art sessions at your grade level and make every effort to not overlap with other grade levels

 - Your grade-level lead will block 15 minutes ahead of your classroom time and 15 minutes after for setup/cleanup

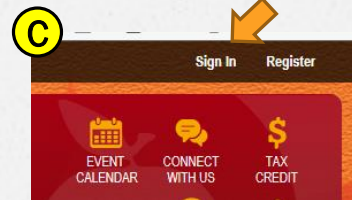
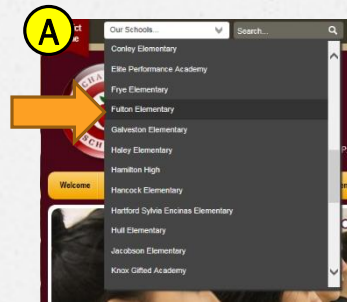
- A. From www.cusd80.com choose Fulton in the "our schools" dropdown box
- B. Choose Art Masterpiece from the Curriculum section
- C. At the top right of the page, click on "sign in"

User name = fireAM

Password = Owen (case sensitive)

IMPORTANT: this is a shared username and password that we all will use. If the wrong password is entered 5 times, we're locked out for 30 minutes. Key carefully!

Rules of the Road

Classroom code of conduct

- o Let the students do a lot of the talking. This is as much about them using their imagination and inquisitive minds as it is about them learning facts about artists and artwork

Displaying artwork

- o Be sure to display the art work outside the teachers room after each lesson is completed (class boards are decorated by volunteers)
- o Artwalk displays must be 18" off the ground, 18" down from the ceiling and cannot be adhered to the colored bricks or within 18" of an outlet
- o Classes will be assigned a lesson and allotted space in the hallways for Artwalk displays

Student Portfolios

- o All art creations are to be kept in a student portfolio in the teacher's room once taken down from the displays
- o Each class has portfolio covers. You only need to add the student's name.
- o Portfolios should be completed and given to teacher by end of **May** to avoid the year-end rush (date TBD)

- o Art to Remember is a great opportunity for parents to purchase keepsake products customized with their child's art!
- o Our only fundraiser for art supplies
- o **Specific paper is required and supplied**
- o Have student sign (or initial) and date the front of artwork at least 1" from the edge of the paper (somewhere within the artwork)
- o If writing on the back of the art, use light pencil. Do not use marker or as it will show through the art
- o Collect artwork, ensuring one for each student
- o Adhere pre-printed labels with student name and class information in the **upper left corner** of the **back of the artwork** to indicate orientation
- o Bundle completed (and dried) artwork together once ALL art is collected and place in provided bin in the workroom (northeast corner)



ALL FINISHED ART WORK MUST BE TURNED IN SEPTEMBER 4th!

Art to Remember Timeline

- Lessons must be completed no later than September 4th
 - Completed art work must be labeled and turned in no later than 3:00pm
- Teachers will distribute personalized order forms to students on October 15th (Return from Fall Break)
- Parents place orders online no later than October 24th
- Orders returned to Fulton and distributed to students in time for the gift giving season!



Lessons and Supplies

Supplies

- o Grade-level specific supplies are in the shelf along with the bin
 - o Each classroom and each project has a folder within the grade-level bin. Please keep bins organized!
 - o After the lesson, return **ALL** supplies in same condition for next class
 - o If running low on supplies, reach out to Sharon, Tori or Talisha to order
 - o Some lessons may require tablecloths, please provide your own (\$1 store or cut up garbage bags and tape around desks)
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- o PREP meetings prior to lessons can be extremely helpful in preparing for the lessons and ensuring all materials are available
 - o Great way to meet your fellow grade volunteers and work together to assist in prepping for other classes that need additional help
 - o Only prep **ONE** lesson at a time. Not necessary to prep multiple lessons ahead

Next Steps

- ❑ Define a grade level coordinator if not already defined.
- ❑ Get acquainted with other volunteers in your classroom and your grade-level coordinator
- ❑ Contact your teacher to schedule your 6 lessons and give that information to your grade-level coordinator so it can be added to the calendar
- ❑ Ensure that Art to Remember (Lesson 1) is completed and in the designated bin in the workroom by Wednesday, September 4th at 3:00pm.
- ❑ Confirm with your teacher where you can display artwork throughout the year
 - ❑ It is your responsibility to decorate and maintain the bulletin board throughout the school year
- ❑ Create your classroom portfolios and leave them with your teacher
 - ❑ File artwork throughout the year
