Class Expectations

Classwork

Homework

Homework will typically be assigned to go along with our daily lesson Monday – Thursday. Homework will be reviewed but only graded for completion. Homework will typically be problems assigned in your math workbook. I will strive to give you some time to get started on homework at the end of every lesson.

Quizzes and Tests

We will have mid-chapter quizzes and end of chapter tests. You have the opportunity to improve your grade on quizzes and tests by doing Test Corrections. You must follow the Test Corrections guidelines (see below) for credit. You can earn half credit back for each item missed.

Test Corrections

You can do test corrections no matter what you scored on your test. My ultimate goal is for you to learn, and analyzing your errors is a great way to learn! You can earn half credit back for each item you missed. Here are the guidelines that you must follow:

- Complete corrections on Test Corrections Form which are in my room and on my website
- Include your original test
- Turn in within one week of receiving graded test

Absences

If you are absent, it is your responsibility to come to me to find out what lessons you missed and what assignments you need to make-up.

Grades

I encourage you to check your grades regularly on Infinite Campus. I typically will update grades once a week, usually over the weekend. You can set notifications to notify you when grades are posted. If you ever have questions or concerns about any of your grades, please don't hesitate to come and talk to me.

Online Book

You can access your book online so you can complete your homework even if you forget your book at school! You may also review the lesson, view additional videos on the lesson, or complete extra practice sheets. To access your book, log in to Clever. Then click on 'ConnectEd' to open your Glencoe book. Select the chapter & lesson we are working on. You can also choose tutoring, step-by-step problem explanations, use math tools, or take a self-check quiz.
