



Annual Transportation Request Information **in Infinite Campus Parent Portal**

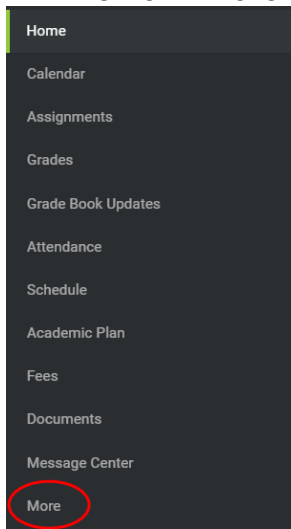
The CUSD Transportation Dept will begin collecting data from parents on whether or not they will be utilizing our bussing to transport their students to/from school (if eligible) starting for the 2023-24 school year.

New to CUSD families will answer the transportation question on their Online Registration Application.

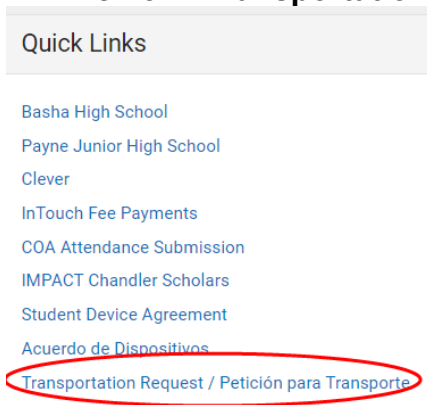
Existing CUSD families will complete the application that's explained in this document.

Transportation Request

Student safety is our No. 1 priority!

- All eligible General Education students needing bus transportation for the upcoming school year MUST register for a bus assignment.
- Eligible denotes any registered CUSD student that resides within CUSD boundaries, is attending a school that is IN boundary based on their legal home address and resides more than 1 mile (Elementary & Junior High) or 1.5 mile (High School) from their homeschool. The mileage is measured by 'how the crow flies'.
- Legal address(es) should be updated with your school's registrar prior to registration.
- Students residing outside of the district boundaries are not eligible for busing.
- Rider status will be evaluated each quarter. Any student assigned a bus, but not riding during the quarter will be unassigned, making room for other eligible students.
- Bus assignments are posted in the student's Infinite Campus Portal. Infinite Campus> More> Transportation.
- Students shall arrive to their designated bus stops 10 min prior to departure time.
- The following schools are **not** eligible for transportation:
 - ACP High School
 - ACP Middle School
 - Basha Accelerated Middle School
 - CTA Freedom
 - CTA Goodman
 - CTA Independence
 - Elite Performance Academy
 - Hill Academy
 - Knox Elementary School
 - Weinberg Elementary School

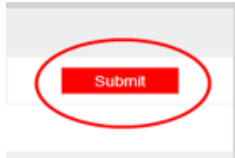
- You will be taken to a screen similar to the one shown below that will list your student(s), their eligibility status, and a yes or no button to select whether you will be utilizing the bussing system.
