Date:	Saturday, October 19, 2019
Time:	Begins at 8:00 am and ends approximately at 11:00 am. (Students should arrive no later than 7:30 am)
Registration:	Registration begins Mon, Aug. 12- Sept. 1st <i>-for Juniors only</i> Monday, September 2, 2019 - Freshman and Sophomores can join register along with Juniors. Tuesday, Sep 17, 2019 at 11:00 PM - Registration Ends Go to the URL address: www.TotalRegistration.net/PSAT/030062 Print out a confirmation form and take it to the Hamilton Bookstore to pay with Hamilton High School ID. *Fri. Sep 20, 2019 - Registrations that have not been paid by 4pm in the Hamilton Bookstore will be canceled and exams will not be ordered.
Location:	Hamilton High School. Report to the cafeteria. Classroom assignments will be posted that morning.
Fee:	\$20.00 Print out a confirmation form and take it to the Hamilton Bookstore to pay with Hamilton ID. Bring a copy of your receipt to C223. (A limited number of fee waivers are available to junior students who are in financial need. See your counselor.)
ID	<u>Bring your HHS student ID for identification.</u> You cannot test without your ID.
