Dear Parent and/or Guardians:

With the beginning of the new school year, we would like to take the opportunity to inform you about the After School Detention (ASD) policy. At Hamilton, we have high expectations for all students. Two such expectations are attending class on time and completing assigned homework.

If a student is late for class (tardy) or does not complete their homework assignment, he/she may receive an After School Detention (ASD) from his/her teacher. It is expected that the student will serve ASD the day of the infraction or the following day. Parents/Guardians may not excuse their student from ASD.

ASD is served after school from 2:25-3:25pm. If the student has a 7th hour class the ASD is served from 3:15-3:40pm. If the student does not attend his/her original assigned detention, he/she will receive an additional day of detention (total of 2 days). If the student misses either of these assigned detentions, he/she will be assigned Tutorial ASD, which runs from either 2:25-5:00pm or 2:25-7:00pm in addition to the originally assigned ASD. Continuous failure to attend ASD will result in a further disciplinary action.
