Chapter Book Exchange!

Hancock students in grades 3-6 are invited to participate in our **2nd Annual Book Exchange** on December 17th, 18th, and 19th. The Book Exchange will be held in the Hancock Library during the school day. Students may bring in gently used books and trade them in for “new to you” books to read. Here is how our Book Exchange will work:

WHO: Students in grades 3-6

WHAT: Bring in softcover or hardcover chapter books that are in good condition and appropriate for students in grades 3-6 with a limit of 5 books per student.

WHEN: Bring donated books to school starting December 3rd, and books will also be accepted during the Book Exchange

WHERE: Times will be set up during the school day on December 17th, 18th, and 19th for students that donated books to come to the Hancock Library and pick out their “new to you” books

WHY: A book exchange is a wonderful opportunity to get a “new to you” gently used book and share an already read book of your own with someone else.

HOW: To avoid books being donated without permission, parents must sign a permission slip before books can be donated. Students should bring this slip with them when they donate the books. No student may exchange books without a signed permission slip.
