Late Work and Make-Up Work

To better serve our students' educational needs and prepare them to meet future expectations of junior high school, the 6th grade team of Hull Elementary will adhere to the following late work policy:

1 day late: 25% off
2 or more days late: 50% off
If never turned in: zero

IEP and 504 Students with documented time extension or students with special circumstances need to adhere to their individual plan.

In addition, teacher discretion will be exercised for large projects/assignments and for work that cannot be made up (examples: labs, warm-ups, in-class assignments/lectures).

For make-up work, teams will adhere to the current district make- up policy, in which students have a day to make up classwork for each day they were absent.

Success Procedures for Students and Parents

- 1. Use your agenda and write all homework down daily.
- 2. Read the nightly email for upcoming assignments and due dates.
- 3. Check the team/teacher website.
- 4. Check Infinite Campus for any missing assignments regularly.
- 5. Come in to zero hour to gather missing assignments, notes, handouts, or for extra help.
- 6. Use the school or team website to email a team teacher if you have guestions.

Zero Hour is a block of time set aside before school in the sixth grade building for students to finish tests or make-up assignments. This is not for individual tutoring or a substitute for before school care. Students who have been absent are expected to utilize this time to catch up on what they missed. Students need to report to the classroom specified below at 7:45 a.m. The doors to the building will be locked at 8:10 a.m. See the schedule provided below.
