



A Letter from the Health Office

As we depart for Spring Break to enjoy our families and get some much needed rest, remember that this is a great time to schedule any necessary doctor or dental appointments. It is also a great time to check in with your students and their progress here at school. Children are always excited to share what they know and are encouraged when we show them that we are interested in that knowledge. It also gives us the opportunity to discuss any concerns or obstacles that they may be experiencing. Collectively as a community, we can insure the health and happiness of our students.

This is also a great time to review any medical conditions that your student may have. On our district website, www.cusd80.com, in the right hand corner you can click the Departments tab and you will find a link to our Health Services webpage. There you will find an array of helpful information, including medical forms, our health protocol and so much more. Please remember that any medications that are required to be taken at school must be accompanied by a Consent for medication administration form and must be brought in by a parent to the health office. You can find this form and our medication administration policy on the Health Services website.

As we all know, lice can be a common problem in schools. Unless we are notified by families or it is noticed while the student is at school, it can be overlooked which leads to spreading within the community. There is a stigma that comes with the presence of lice and this at times can be emotionally difficult for the student. It is important to remember that this is a treatable issue and that your child needs your reassurance that it isn't due to their lack of cleanliness. Please be sure to be diligent about checking your student's hair every so often and notifying the health office when lice are found. If you have a concern about a lice presence, please feel free to contact me anytime. I can assist you with resources and what to look for when inspecting your child's hair. Rest assured, this is something we can overcome together.

Cold and allergy season is upon us. Please remember that the health office does not carry cold or allergy medication. It is advised to give your child medication before school and again as soon as they come home from school if needed. Remind your students to continue with good hand washing, get plenty of sleep and to drink plenty of water. Please carefully assess your child before sending them to school and see your doctor for any concerns. A child who is sick will not be able to perform well in school and would benefit from rest and treatment at home.






