Welcome to Jacobson's 20th year of offering a club designed to promote the study of earth science, mathematics, technology and astronomy related subjects. The curriculum for this program has evolved using materials from the Young Astronaut Council, the Orbital Sciences Corp. (a supplier of many of our volunteer instructors) and a plethora of Internet-based items including NASA's educational materials. In addition to five class lessons during lunch, which often include experiments and demonstrations, each student will assemble, and launch a reusable seltzer rocket!

Seltzer Rocket Launch date: TBD

Discipline: Students are expected to attend each session if they are at school that day and to behave with respect and in accordance with the school's policies.

Volunteers: We need your help to make this program a success. Complete lessons are provided. We just need your time and an adult to present the lessons. Three adults in each class is ideal. It is just 45 minutes a month. Volunteer sign up sheets will come home with your child's enrollment confirmation.

The enrollment fee is \$10.00 per student to help with the cost of the seltzer rockets and lesson materials. The groups meet during the lunch/recess break on the dates listed above. Students are asked to bring their lunches on these days so there is a little more time for each lesson.
