What We're Learning

Reading- This week in reading we will be reading an informational text about schools entitled: <u>Schools.</u> We will be focusing on reading skills such as main idea and detail along with analyze and evaluate our learning to better understand the text.

Writing- We will be looking at the elements of a persuasive letter and write a letter to Mr. Hickey trying to persuade him to allow us to go on a field trip of our choosing.

Math- We will be working on finding the perimeter, subtracting a number from ten, having our written assessment, making a shape for a given perimeter, constructing a number line, and adding two-digit numbers using the addition algorithm. Social Studies- We finished Ancient China and will now be working on India as our culture of study for the next week.
