What We're Learning

Reading- This week we will be reading: Ah, Music. We will be looking at answering the question: what are different ways to enjoy music? We will be focusing reading skills such as using text features and asking questions to better understand the story.

Writing- We will be writing a paragraph following a mentor text called: Magical Pen. Students will be writing about what they would do if they had a magical pen. We will be focusing on expanding and rearranging sentences to make the text more interesting.

Math- We will be completing lessons on naming line segments, identifying and making scalene, isosceles, and equilateral triangles, identifying a missing digit in an addition problem, a fact test, and a written assessment. Just a reminder students will be bringing home homework daily so please be sure to check in with them and ask them about which topic we are studying.

Social Science- We will be digging into Ancient China. Students will be learning about the land features of China, the importance of red and dragons to the culture.

Spalding- Students should be practicing their 30 spelling words. We will be testing on FRIDAY so, please be ready. We will also be introducing our spelling words for next week in class this week with our phonogram practice.

Grammar- We are working on expanding and rearranging compound sentences.
