## What We're Learning

**Reading-** This week we will be reading: <u>Teachers Pet.</u> While reading the story we will be working on such reading skills as visualizing the text and using our comprehension part of the brain to identify the structure of the text: characters, setting, plot, problem, solution.

**Writing-** We will be working on working on writing a informational paragraph that describes our school day emphasizing the order and the use of linking words.
