#### Parent Involvement: Ways you can participate


- 1. If you have a passion for a particular culture and would be willing to come share your experience.

Carl Orff (1895-1982) defined the ideal music for children as "never alone, but connected with movement, dance and speech - not to be listened to, meaningful only in active participation.

Build understanding of musical concepts and skills through *experience*.

Speech/chants, movement, singing, drama and playing pitched/unpitched instruments.

Explore loco-motor and non-locomotor movements
