CADET BAND

- Standard of Excellence by Pearson Book 2 (blue) for your instrument
- Excellence in Theory (workbook) by Ryan Nowlin and Bruce Pearson, Book 1 (red)
- (2) Paper folders with pockets and 3 prongs, and 15 plastic sheet protectors for music. This will fit into a section in your PJHS binder but will be easily removable to put on your stand during rehearsals. You will need 2 of these to ensure proper care of your music all year.
- Instrument accessories and cleaning materials (listed by instrument below)
- Class fee of \$30. You can pay this using the parent portal on infinite campus, or by sending cash or check to the front office

SYMPHONIC BAND

- Technique and Musicianship from the Tradition of Excellence Series (Nowlin/Pearson)- method book
- Excellence in Theory (workbook) by Ryan Nowlin and Bruce Pearson, Book 2 (blue)
- (2) Paper folders with pockets and 3 prongs and 15 plastic sheet protectors for music. This will fit into a section in your PJHS binder but will be easily removable to put on your stand during rehearsals. You will need 2 of these to ensure proper care of your music all year.
- Instrument accessories and cleaning materials (listed by instrument below)
- Class fee of \$30. You can pay this using the parent portal on infinite campus, or by sending cash or check to the front office

JAZZ BAND

- Standard of Excellence Jazz Ensemble Method book for your instrument. WAIT TO PURCHASE this until your
 instrument and part are confirmed by Mrs. Bessette. You will find out the first week of school during class.
- (2) Paper folders with pockets and 3 prongs, 15 plastic sheet protectors for music. This will fit into a section in your PJHS binder but will be easily removable to put on your stand during rehearsals. You will need 2 of these to ensure proper care of your music all year. You may combine this with your folder for Cadet or Symphonic band if you wish, just get more plastic sheet protectors to ensure you have enough for all of your music.
- Instrument accessories and cleaning materials (listed by instrument below)
- Class fee of \$30. You can pay this using the parent portal on infinite campus, or by sending cash or check to the front

PERCUSSION ENSEMBLE:

- The Snare Drummer's Toolbox from Row Loff Percussion- method book.
- Completed "Application for Instrument Rental" and one-time \$40 fee. This a rental fee for use of all of the school instruments that are covered in this class (marimba, bass drum, snare, toms, tam-tam, marching percussion, cymbals, etc.) This can be paid by sending cash or check with the completed form to the front office.
- Class fee of \$30. You can pay this using the parent portal on infinite campus, or by sending cash or check to the front office
- (2) Paper folders with pockets and 3 prongs, 15 plastic sheet protectors for music. This will fit into a section in your PJHS binder but will be easily removable to put on your stand during rehearsals. You will need 2 of these to ensure proper care of your music all year.

Clarinet: handkerchief swab, cork grease, 3 playable reeds brand Van Doren, mouthpiece brush, quality reed holder

Suggested Mouthpiece: Van Doren M13 or B45, Rovner Ligature.

Saxophone: handkerchief swab, 3 playable reeds brand Van Doren, cork grease, quality reed holder, mouth piece brush

Suggested Mouthpiece: Selmer C star

Trumpet: valve oil (Al Cass), slide grease, cleaning snake & cloth, polishing cloth,

Suggested Mouthpiece: Bach 5C or 3C.

French Horn: rotary oil, slide grease, mouthpiece brush, cleaning snake

Suggested Mouthpiece: Giardinelli C8.

Trombone/Baritone: trombotine slide oil, (Al Cass valve oil for baritones), tuning slide grease, cleaning snake, small spray bottle for water, mouthpiece brush,

polishing cloth Suggested Mouthpiece: Bach 6-1/2 AL.

<u>Tuba</u>: valve oil (Al Cass), slide grease, mouthpiece brush, cleaning snake SuggestedMouthpiece:

Schilke 67

Percussion: Practice pad for home practice, at least 2 pairs of sticks, a set of bells is recommended but not required

CONCERT POLICIES

Part of what we learn in band is teamwork and cooperation and we rely on each other to make a successful performance. <u>ALL PERFORMANCES ARE MANDATORY!</u> I MUST receive parent contact at least 2 weeks prior to the concert if you have a previous conflict that is unchangeable. If an excused absence is granted, an alternate assignment would be offered to the student to make up the points for the missed concert. An unexcused missed performance will result in an automatic lowering of AT LEAST TWO letter grades!! Please mark your calendars now with the attached performance schedule, and be sure to check the website and flyers sent home with your student for any changes.

INSTRUMENT STORAGE

You may check out a locker in the band room to store your instrument while you go to your other classes. A school combination lock will be provided. These lockers are ONLY for the storage of your musical instrument and band materials and must be kept locked at all times. It is school property and will be inspected throughout the year to ensure appropriate use. If it is determined that your locker is being used improperly, you will lose the locker immediately. If you lose your lock, you will be charged a \$5.00 replacement fee. Any student found tampering with other lockers will automatically lose their locker privileges and will receive a referral.

GRADING

Your band grade will be calculated by averaging your scores from the following: PERFORMANCES, Rehearsals (class participation), Practice sheets, Written assignments and Playing tests

CONCERT ATTIRE (Cadet, Symphonic Band, Percussion Ensemble)

You will be responsible for providing the uniform, which is: white collared shirt, black dress pants, black dress shoes and black socks.
