

- Dual enrollment is an opportunity for eligible high school students to earn college credit during their regular high school classes.
- The credits students earn through dual enrollment are treated the same as regular college credit.
- They can be transferred to other Maricopa Community Colleges, Arizona's state universities, and even some out-ofstate colleges. or universities

By participating in CGCC's dual enrollment program, you earn college credit that can fulfill many university general studies requirements, including English, math, science, history and language courses.

This means you pay community college prices for university-level classes. Savings also occur because your high school provides the necessary text books. You are able to complete a four-year degree program more quickly due to transferred credits.

■ Community College tuition rates are much lower than rates for a state university. Dual Enrollment students pay roughly I/3 the tuition they would pay at a state university. For parents planning on paying for their child's college tuition, this can be a huge help.

■ For the 2018-2019 year, the **in-state** tuition rate is \$85 per credit hour. There are additional charges for students classified as out-of-state. There is also a \$15 registration fee once *per semester* for each community college.

CAN I GET TUITION ASSISTANCE?

- A tuition assistance form is available to students who can demonstrate financial need. Applications submitted now will be approved and awarded on a first come, first served basis until funding runs out.

AM I ELIGIBLE TO ENROLL IN THIS CLASS?

■ Dual enrollment students must be attending Perry High and meet the **prerequisite criteria** for the course or have a qualifying **placement score** by taking an appropriate assessment test.

WHAT PLACEMENT TEST?

Ask the teacher for the course you wish to take what the full requirements are, but here is a general guideline for the placement tests:

- Math courses require a certain score earned on the Math Accuplacer.
 Some math classes allow the use of a "Multiple Measures" to help gain entrance into the class. Your math teacher will let you know which class uses this (in case you don't receive a passing placement score).
- College Prep English requires a passing score (5+) on the Write Placer or a
 4-5 on ITAP Language and Composition test.
- ALL other classes require a "proficient" or "highly proficient" score on a current AzMerit test (9th-11th grades) or a passing score on the Reading Accuplacer.

WHAT IF I DON'T PASS THE PLACEMENT TEST?

- Students are allowed to take the placement test TWICE within a short period of time. If a THIRD and final attempt needs to be made, a three month period must pass before the final attempt is made to pass.
- The math and English tests are given at Perry during the spring.
- The Reading Accuplacer is given at Perry during the first month of the new school year. All in-coming 9th graders and those students who did not pass the reading portion of the AzMERIT must take the reading Reading Accuplacer.

READING ACCUPLACER

During the Week of August 6th – 10th, the Reading Accuplacer will be given in the Career Center (F219)

If you need to take the Reading Accuplacer, please report to the Career Center after school during the testing week.

Bring your ID (driver's license or PHS card) and your CGCC student number (it begins with the number 3).

You cannot test without proof of ID and your CGCC student number

THERE ARE 4 STEPS TO BECOME A DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENT:

- Step I- Get Admitted (if you haven't already done so)
- * Submit Identification (optional online)
- Step 2- Take the placement test (if you need to)
- Step 3- Submit the Registration form to your Dual Enrollment teacher
- Step 4- Once the college has come to PHS to register you, you can pay for the course(s) on line.

STEP I- GET ADMITTED


Creating an MEID number will give you access to your college account (you can see your grades, send email, and make payments).

Once you create the MEID number, you will also receive a CGCC student number (this number begins with a 3). You will need the CGCC number to take placement tests and complete the hard copy registration form.



Before You Begin

Thank you for your interest in the Maricopa Community Colleges. Before you begin the online admission application, please be sure to have this information available:

- · One of the following forms of photo ID:
 - State-issued Identification Card
 - State-issued Drivers License

Note: Other forms of ID are not accepted while admitting online. You may verify your identity after admitting by visiting a college or using the E-Forms process. Just choose "Submit Later as E-Form or In-Person" while admitting if you choose not to verify your identity online.

- Access to a camera OR a scanned, color copy of your ID (front and back). If you are using a scanned image, please be sure to save as an image file (.jpeg, .gif, .png). Word documents or .pdf files cannot be processed.
- Access to an email address; this should be the address you use during the application process
- Access to internet, either through Wi-Fi or a cellular data connection.

Helpful Tips

- Please note you must complete your application within 48 hours from the time you start. All incomplete applications will be removed after that time for the security of your personal information.
- · Your name on the online application must match your name on your identification.
- · When taking photos of the ID with a camera or mobile device, use a darker background. Please ensure the image is clear and free of glare or reflections.
- On some mobile devices, please wait for the images to upload from your smartphone into the application. The application will show you a preview of the images before you submit them online.

(OPTIONAL ONLINE) PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION

- CGCC needs proof of your identification. You must provide a current Driver's License <u>Or</u> a Birth Certificate with a photo ID such as a current PHS ID
- You may **either** submit a <u>hard copy</u> of this proof of ID and attach it to your registration form <u>Or</u> you may follow the next four steps listed on the Power Point. The steps for on-line submission of identification will be indicated with a YOU MAY FIND IT EASIER TO SIMPLY SUPPLY A HARD COPY OF THE ID ^③
- YOU DO NOT HAVE TO DO BOTH AN ON-LINE AND HARD COPY SUBMISSION of identification. *Please choose one way to submit proof of identification*.
- If you plan to submit proof of ID with a hard copy, you may SKIP all of the next slides that indicate on-line submission of ID.
- All Students will still need to complete one more step after the slides concerning on-line submission of identification.

How to Submit Your ID for Authentication

Maricopa Community Colleges require students to submit a valid form of identification for authentication. This allows us to confirm a student's identity and prevent identity theft. Students can submit their identification inperson at any of our Admissions, Records, and Registration offices, or online.

If you have to take the Math Accuplacer or the English 101 Writeplacer – please go the CGCC campus and find the **Coyote Center**. Bring an ID photo and your CGCC student number (it begins with a 3). Ask your teacher if you are unsure about whether you still need to take a placement test.

Remember, you do not have to take the Reading Accuplacer UNLESS you did NOT pass a recent AZMerit ELA test with a "proficient" or higher or you are a freshman.


