- On your registration form you will circle Freshman Football. This class will count as your PE credit.
- Students who play football will not be able to participate in JROTC, Marching Band or take a zero hour the first semester of their freshman year.

Wednesday Game Day- Go to 2nd hour-no AM practice

Thursday-Friday 5:45-7:45 a.m.

In order to accommodate zero hour practice and remain in compliance with CUSD requirements for enrollment, it is mandatory for players to take one of their freshman courses online at Chandler Online Academy for at least the first semester of their freshman year. Depending on availability of courses, players may be able to take a zero hour at Perry second semester. More information regarding this process will be reviewed at the Freshman Football meeting in the spring.

- Check the box for zero hour on your registration form.
- Write COA – FB in the top right corner of the form.
- Highlight the course which you plan take on line. (Most students choose to take World History.) Honors classes can be taken at COA.
- Circle the Football P.E. class on the registration form.
