COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The topics that we will be covering are: Basic Geometry, Parallel and Perpendicular Lines, Transformations, Congruent Triangles, Relationships within Triangles, Quadrilaterals and Other Polygons, Similarity, Right Triangles and Trigonometry, Circles, Circumference, Area and Volume.

TEXTBOOK:

Student textbooks are online and can be accessed through Infinite Campus or the clever.com website. There are several online resources for you to use, including practice tests, extra problems, video tutorials, and live tutors.

DAILY ROUTINE:

- Upon entering the classroom and the bell has rung, please follow this procedure:
 - ✓ Cell phones shut off and placed in the designated place at the front of the classroom. All ear buds or air pods away in backpacks.
 - ✓ Be in your assigned seat.
 - ✓ Begin completing warm up and be prepared to do a problem at the board.
 - ✓ Have questions ready over the previous night's homework/classwork and make corrections.
 - ✓ Be prepared to start taking notes immediately after questions are answered.

ABSENCES and MAKE-UP WORK:

- Late homework may be accepted until the end of the chapter for partial credit.
- Excused absences will have as many days as you were absent to make up the assignment(s) for full credit.
- If you are absent on a test day, you **MUST** take the test, after school.
- It is your responsibility to make up what you missed.

TESTS and QUIZZES (80%)

HOMEWORK, CLASSWORK, PARTICIPATION (20%)

- There will be daily homework. Homework grades are 25 points for 80% or better, 20 points for 60% to 79.9%, 15 points for 40% to 59.9%, 10 points for 20% to 39.9%, 5 points for 1% to 19.9%.
- Inappropriate behavior will result in the loss of participation points for the day. This is your one warning and points cannot be recovered.
- Participation points can be made up in case of an excused absence by creating 10 problems based on what we are doing in class that day or 20 problems for block day absences.

GRADES:

- **Grades are cumulative throughout the entire semester; grades do not reset each quarter.** Per district policy, your semester grade is based on 20% of the Final Exam and 80% of the Semester Cumulative grade.
- Semester cumulative grade are broken down as follows. Semester cumulative grade counts 80% from tests and quizzes and 20% from homework, classwork, participation, etc.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS:
