DANCE MAKE-UP WORK

When you are absent you lose participation points. If your absence is excused, please choose one of the following assignments to make-up your points. Option 1 is preferred.

Option 1: (highly recommended) Attend Tech Tuesday. Dates are posted in locker room and on handout given in class. Sign in when you arrive, when makeup work is due let your teacher know to check the sign in sheet for the date(s) you attended.

Option 2: Write a brief (1 page typed, 12 pt. Times font, double-spaced) research paper of a dance company, a dancer and/or a choreographer. Suggestions are listed on the next page. The paper should contain information about the artist's life **and** career, or company's background **and** progress. Write in paragraph form and be sure to use complete sentences, correct spelling, and proper grammar, punctuation and citations. Be sure to include a reference page of at least 3 sources you used. You may use information from the internet, magazines, or books. **This assignment must be submitted to turnitin.com as well as printed out and submitted in class.** Assignments not uploaded to turnitin.com will not be given credit. Class codes can be found on your teacher's website.

Option 3: Create a dance poster detailing your research on a dance company, dancer and/ or a choreographer. The poster must be creative, legible and neat. You must use standard poster board, and should include the following:

- 5 quality pictures of the dancer/choreographer/company
- 5 factual details about the dancer/choreographer/company
- Title including the dancer/choreographer/company's full name
- MLA Format Works Cited attached to back of poster
- Your name, class period and date of absence on back of poster

Due Dates

Make-up work must be turned in at the next due date after the absence, and within the same quarter as the absence. Please note that make-up work is due on the specified dates, and will not be accepted late.

What if I am absent on the due date? If you have chosen option 1, you must upload your paper to turnitin.com and email the paper to your teacher before 3:15 on the due date. If you have created a poster (option #2) you'll need to take a picture of it and email the picture to your teacher by 3:15 on the due date. Then bring your poster when you return.
