
Manifest Destiny

1841-1848

"....Tyler too"



Switched parties b/c he did not agree w/ Jackson personally

Belonged to minority (states rights faction) of the Whig party

Different from Clay-Webster:

- Passed bill to repeal Independent Treasury
- Vetoed bill to renew the National Bank
- Entire Cabinet (Whigs) resigned

"War" with England

Fought primarily in the press (p 398 in text)

Caroline Incident


- Rebellion in Canada
- Steamer carried supplies for insurgents was sunk by British. 1 American was killed.
- Stirred up anger at British.

Aroostook War

- Lumberjack quarrel over disputed territory in Maine
- Resulted in hard Canada-ME border




Mandate for Manifest Destiny?



Mexican-American War (Causes):

"Can you show me the precise spot where American blood has been shed..."



California:

- Proponents of Manifest Destiny wanted to control CA (Sea to shining Sea)
- Polk offered to buy CA from Mexico, but annexation of TX was a point of friction
- Polk sent John Slidell to offer \$25 million

Texas:

- Border Dispute (Rio Grande v Nueces River)
- Taylor ordered into disputed territory
- Mexican forces attacked Taylor "American blood on American soil"

April 25, 1846: Congress declares war

Opposition to the War

"When a sixth of the population of a nation which has undertaken to be the refuge of liberty are slaves, and a whole country is unjustly overrun and conquered by a foreign army, and subjected to military law, I think that it is not too soon for honest men to rebel and revolutionize. Mexican-American War (Course): CA:



Fremont sent to CA in 1845 Bear Flag Revolt Naval Action (Stockton) Invasion (Kearny)

Mexico: Taylor invades Mexico and defeats Santa Anna at Buena Vista (coup)



Mexican-American War (Course): Scott invaded Mexico

Scott invaded Mexico and laid siege to the capital

April 1847: Scott defeated Santa Anna outside Cerro

Respect Won: Europe Respect Lost: South America

Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo

Wilmot Proviso:

- Wilmot wanted to prevent spread of slavery into Mexican Cession
- Southern Dems fought bill successfully
- Symbol of anti-slavery campaign
