One inch binder with two sections

Section 1 of the Handbook

Keep these in your Handbook for the entire year

1. The first section contains all the instruction guidelines you will need throughout the year--the syllabus, the AP Course Outline, instructions & rubrics on how to take notes on their readings, write FRQ's and DBQ's, discussion strategies, primary source analysis strategies
2. Section one stays in the Historian's Handbook for the entire year until the very end.

Section 2 of the Handbook

1. Unit study guide, all handouts, lecture notes, reading notes for the current unit we are studying.
2. Students are expected to bring this notebook to class every period. At the end of each unit I will collect and grade the Handbook.

Comprehensive Notebook

At the end of each Chapter, students take the Section 2 handbook contents and transfer them to their comprehensive notebook. The comprehensive notebook (a 3 inch binder) should have a divider for each chapter. When we come back from spring break they will use the comprehensive notebook to review at 1st semester and prepare for the AP Exam.
