### Reading

### **Social Studies**

This week we will finish up our unit on Egypt and read and learn about St. Patrick's Day! Our expert, Kenzie, will teach us more about Dr. Seuss.

Writing We will do some fun St. Patrick's Day writing prompts.

Math We continue our unit on geometry focusing on 3 D solid shapes as well as decomposing shapes to make new shapes. Our theme is "Star Wars" and the shapes we are learning include: Hans "Cylinder", Luke "Sphere" Walker, "Cone" Bacca, Darth "Pyramid", Princess "Prism", and "Cube" 3PO. We also compared the geometric shapes to items we have in our classroom and at home. These shapes are all around us! The kids will continue exploring various geometric shapes, and <u>my goal is that your</u> child will be able to identify each shape, count the vertices, edges (straight & curved) and faces of each of these shapes!
