#### Vocabulary Strategies Antonyms

Spelling This week we will review the short vowel, e. (short e sound) and work with words that have blends with s. We are tapping out words, building words, doing word sorts, unscrambling sentences and finding words that include short e and blends in our daily readings. We also play spelling sparkle & spelling battleship!

Spelling words this week: yes, let, red, ten, bed, get, step, sled

Our challenge words are: Checked, pigpen, present

High Frequency Words (sight/trick words): after, draw, pictures, read, was, write

Math This week we continue working on adding and subtraction to 20 including adding 3 digits. We will be using manipulatives, ten frames, number lines, and strategies such as doubles +1, counting on, etc.

#### Family Turkey Projects

Before break, students brought home a fun art/writing project. Their mission? To disguise turkeys! They can disguise their turkey in any Creative way they want! Examples: Minions, ninjas, football players, ballerinas, etc.! They will also write a short story about their disguised turkey. Projects are due Monday, Nov. 4.
