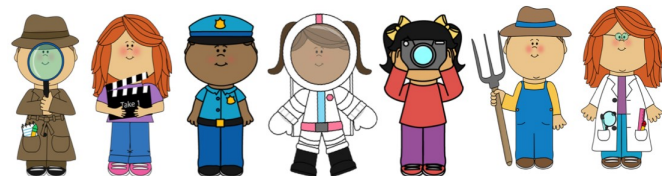
Spelling words this week sad, sadly, slow, slowly, dust, dusty, trick, tricky, help, helpful.
