### **Vocabulary Strategies**

**Spelling** We continue to work on more long vowels. This week our focus is long o. (CV & CVCe). We will play spelling battleship, finding long a words in books, do word sorts, white board spelling and unscrambling sentences.

Spelling words this week: so, go, home, hole, no, rope, joke, bone, stove, poke

It is important your child can remember these spelling words and write them correctly for all of their writing, not just for the spelling

Our challenge words are: snowglobe, wrote,

High Frequency Words (sight/trick words): around, because, before, bring, carry, light, show, and think.

Fundations We are starting unit 8. During this 2 week unit, we'll be focusing on consonant blends, diagraph blends as well as r controlled vowels. Some of the blends include sl, fl, st, pr, br, cl, pl R controlled vowels include ar, or, er, ir and ur.

100th Day! On Jan. 16th, we will celebrate 100th day. I have a whole day of great activities planned! I am asking that everyone brings in 100 small stickers for an activity that we will be doing. Please let me know if this is a problem.

Math We are starting our unit on collecting and organizing data. We will be working on writing and reading tally marks, creating pictographs and reading and analyzing pictographs next week.
