<u>Vocabulary Strategies</u> Compound Words

<u>Spelling</u> This week we will work on compound words.

<u>Spelling words this week:</u> bedtime, sunset, bathtub, sailboat, flagpole, backpack, playpen, rain coat, inside, himself.

*I know I keep mentioning this, but a lot of kids are memorizing the words and getting them correct on their tests. However, they are not spelling correctly during other writing times. It is important your child can remember these spelling words and write them correctly for all of their writing, not just for the spelling test.
