


Mrs. Dafoe's August 2, 2021

Reading This week our focus stories is <u>The Storm</u>

Genres Realistic Fiction

Target skill Understanding characters

<u>Phonics</u> We continue to review letters and sounds. We are working on identifying key words/pictures with each letter and the correct sounds. We are also tapping out our words- hearing all the sounds.

Grammar Writing complete sentences

Spelling This week we will focus on the vowel, i. (short i sound) We continue to work on building words, doing word sorts, and finding words that include short i in our daily readings.

Spelling words this week: if, is, him, rip, fit, pin

Our challenge words: ship, flick, this High Frequency Words to know: he, look, have, for, too, what

<u>Writing</u> We are working on how sentences need a subject and a predicate along with a capital and punctuation. Please reinforce writing complete sentences on homework.

<u>Social Sciences</u> Rules and procedures, communities, and friendship

Math We are continuing to work on addition number sentences. We are using "CUBES" (circle your numbers, underline the question, box math action words, eliminate extra information, solve and check) to solve story problems. We are learning the symbols of "+" and "=", and what they mean. We have been learning math vocabulary words like "sum". We have been solving addition

number sentences using our part-part-whole maps.
