

Homework Your child is bringing their homework packet home today, and it is due back on Friday. Homework is not meant to be hard, it is a review of our concepts. Please study the spelling words on the front page as well and read at least 15 minutes nightly. The kids will be tested on Friday!

<u>Snacks</u> Please send your child with a snack daily.

<u>Reading</u> This week our theme story is <u>What is a Pal?</u> This story is all about being a good friend, and it is an informational text. The kids will learn about the main idea and discuss details & summarize.

<u>Grammar</u> This week we will introduce nouns and identify nouns in our stories!

Spelling Our sound this week is working with the short vowel, a. We will be doing word sorts, making words, rainbow spelling, and we'll play spelling sparkle for review. Our first spelling test will be on Friday, and it will include 6 words. Spelling words: **am**, **at**, **sat**, **man**, **dad**, **mat**. There will be 3 challenge words: **dash**, **that**, & **flat**. Please work with your child on their words using them in sentences so they understand the word. Remember, the goal is for your child to remember how to spell these words and use them in writing regularly, **not** just to memorize them.

<u>Writing</u> We will be introducing FUNdations to the students. We will work on identifying lines and making letter formations correctly within the lines *Refer to your homework folder for the correct letter formations.

<u>Math</u> This year we will be using a math program called <u>My Math</u>. We will be working on addition concepts in this unit.
