Approval of Minutes:

• Minutes from the August 4, 2016 PTO meeting were approved

Principal's Report (Amy O'Neal):

- Mrs. O'Neal talked about the first big assembly of the year that was held last Friday
 - Kicked off Red Ribbon week, Drug Free & Bully Free Week
 - Announced winners for the poster contest for the new anti-bullying poster
 - \circ The two girls who won received a 16x20 size of their poster and will get a free yearbook
- Santan Elementary is working on our A+ application we are applying this year for first time
 - There is committee formed to gather input/feedback from staff, parents, students
 - \circ $\,$ Putting together information that showcases what this school is doing that is amazing
 - \circ $\,$ We want to tell everyone what we are about at Santan Elementary
 - The goal is to have a solid rough draft by mid-November, with final draft due by beginning of January
 - District is doing things to help us and are very supportive of the effort
 - District is having our grass redone, replanting plants, and hopefully repainting the steel columns, trusses, and walkways

Financial Report (Bekki Patzer):

- Our big fundraiser in the first quarter (Q1) was the Check Writing campaign
 - We raised about \$12,000, but are still waiting on some matching funds from companies
- Biggest spends so far this year are for subscriptions (such as Scholastic)

Committee Reports:

• Back to School BINGO

- \circ This is the 2nd time we have done it, and it is a nice (free) activity for the families
- We had a wonderful turnout and everything went well we had some sound system problems that we will work out for the next big event
- This is not a money making event for the PTO, but due to sales at the event, we raised between \$300-500
- We will be leaving this event in August (even the monsoon didn't affect the event!)
- Principal O'Neal let us know that if we give District advance notice of the event, they can have the temps lowered in the room

• Check Writing Campaign

- This is the 3rd year of doing this the PTO board will decide if we do it again next year
- \circ We had about one quarter of the students participate this year
- We will be looking at success of Run-a-Thon in the Spring
- Feedback from a parent to not run grade level fundraisers at the same time/week
- \circ $\,$ Grade level fundraisers are for specific grades, and may still require selling of items $\,$

• Grandparents Day

- We had a lot of families this year breakfast in MPR and then time spent in classrooms
- Teachers said it was great turnout and grandparents really enjoyed themselves
- Some finished breakfast early and wanted to go to the classrooms before school started (8am), so we may want to take a look at the start time for breakfast
- For some kids who didn't have grandparents there, it was hard for them during the classroom activities
- A lot of teachers had group activities for kids without family there, and kids seemed to really enjoy that
- Parents can come too instead of grandparents
- Feedback that some Grandparents said they wanted more than just a donut for breakfast, even if they had to pay for it

• Box Tops

- Counting of the first round of Box Tops is now complete, and we raised \$1353 (we receive \$.10 per box top, and more for bonus box tops)
- We are on track to hit our goal of \$4000 for the year (3 collection rounds)
- Feedback from teacher coordinators to have more parents volunteer to verify classroom envelopes to help the process go faster during final counts/verifications
- Box Tops turned in on the sheets of paper are easier for the coordinator, as long as they are doing only 25 to a sheet and none are expired

 - o Santa Shop will be held in the Music room near the MPR
 - They will have a collection box for the Toy Drive for any leftover money
 - Santan Elementary merchandise will also be for sale

New Business

• Santan Safety Committee

- Parent Volunteers (in orange vests) are working hard in the parking lots after school to make sure all safety rules are being followed

- Feedback that a lot of kids are skipping crosswalks and walking out into the street

- Reminder from Principal O'Neal that riding scooters to school is NOT allowed (it is noted in the District Handbook that the district does not allow scooters anywhere on school grounds)
- Riding a bicycle to school is ok if you are in 2nd grade or above (Kinder and 1st Graders must ride with a parent if they want to ride their bike to school)

• Run-a-Thon

- Emily Slater is leading the Run-a-thon, and it is in the planning phases
- The students will collect pledges, learn about being active and raise money for the school
- We are running it ourselves and will get all of the money raised directly for the school (we are not using an outside company)
- We will need a planning team, other volunteers, as well as sponsorships and donations
- Students will have a Bib that goes on their shirt with their number, and after the race the Bib will come off and go onto a certificate for them
- Students will get a pedometer to track their steps during the week
- The run itself will be held on Feb 3rd, and the students will be running around the Santan Jr. High track we will be doing things to make it fun for the kids during the run
- We need corporate sponsors to help pay for all of the costs associated with the Run-a-Thon, so that all of the money raised will go to directly to Santan
- Opens
 - Principal O'Neal mentioned that we will NOT have a Friday lunch for parents during the Santan Carnival day (Nov 4th) since there will be no extra seating available in the MPR, and all parts of the MPR will be used in preparation for the carnival
