

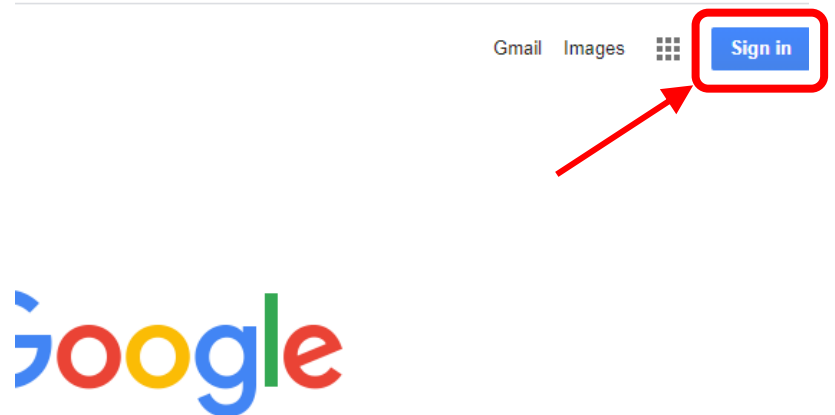
Google Classroom Student Sign In and Password Info

Your username is s+ID@gse.cusd80.com (ex: s123456@gse.cusd80.com)

****Your password has been changed to s+ID+! (ex: s123456!)**

1. To access Google Classroom, you need to sign in to Google:

- a. Open Chrome, search in the URL bar for Google, and then you'll see the blue Sign In button.



2. Sign in with your **username**:

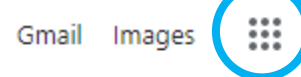
s123456@gse.cusd80.com

Your **username** for Google (access to Classroom, Docs, Slides, etc.) is: s+ID@gse.cusd80.com (s123456@gse.cusd80.com)

(Use your own ID#, not 123456)

3. Your **password** has been changed to s+ID+! Ex: s123456!

4. Go to the App Launcher (the 9 dots waffle icon)

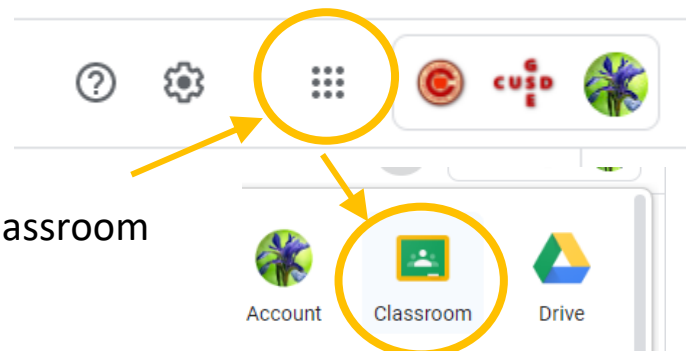


5. Click on the Drive icon.
(The Google Classroom Icon does not appear at first.)



Drive is where you have access to Google Docs, Forms, Slides, Drawings, etc.

6. Once you've clicked on the Drive icon, you'll notice the CUSD icon in the upper right corner. Click the App Launcher again and you will now see the Google Classroom icon.



7. You can then open Classroom and see your classes.

8. Note: If you need to access Classroom on your phone, go to the app store for your device and find the correct app to download. You may also need to download additional apps, like Google Drive, Google Slides, Google Docs, Google Drawings, etc. to complete your assignments. Android users may need to install Google Apps Device Policy. Once they download this app, and login with their GSE account, it will create a work profile on their phone. This prohibits the district from accessing their personal information on their phones.
