

ADMISSION

Your child must be <u>5 years of age by August 31st</u> to register for the 2015-2016 school year.

- If your child's turns 5 years of age between
 September 1st December 31st, s/he may be tested for Early Kindergarten Entrance.

KINDERGARTEN READINESS INDICATORS

Social & Emotional

- Sits quietly for 10-15 min
- Shares with others (teamwork)
- Follows simple 2-3 step directions
- Exhibits self-control and respect for others
- Reacts appropriately to consequences or redirection
- Separates from parents
- Exhibits self-control and respect for others

Language, Listening & Speaking

- Pays attention to adult-directed tasks and direction
- Speaks clearly using complete simple sentences using 5-6 words
- Listens to stories without interruption
- Uses imagination to tell or retell a story by looking at pictures
- Recognizes rhyming sounds



KINDERGARTEN READINESS INDICATORS

Large & Fine Motor Skills

- Prints his/her name.
- Uses pencil & scissors correctly
- Draws basic shapes.
- Walks and runs without falling.
- Turns pages in a book easily.

Self-Management

- Can say his/her first and last name clearly.
- Manages bathroom needs independently.
- Is able to feed themselves.
- Ties shoes independently or with very little help.



KINDERGARTEN READINESS INDICATORS

Pre-Reading Skills

Pre-Math Skills

- Traces and/or writes letters and numbers.
- Recites & recognizes letters of the alphabet.
- Recognizes sight words and environmental print (i.e. stop).
- Identifies rhyming words.
- Starting to identify the beginning letter sound of words.

- Names basic shapes.
- Understanding of times of day (morning, afternoon, evening).
- Sorts similar objects by color, size, and shape.
- Counts from 1-20+ & recognizes most numbers 1-20
- One-to-one correspondence while counting



SPECIAL AREA CLASSES

Students receive (2) 30-minute sessions with our special areas teachers of the following classes during a 6-day rotation:

- Physical Education
- Music Education





LUNCH TIME



- 20 minutes on the playground & 20 minutes in the cafeteria.
- Students may purchase school lunch or bring a sack lunch from home.
