### Tiny Books. Will They Change the Way We Read?

Dwarsliggers "tiny, pocket size, horizontal flipbacks have become a wildly popular print format in the Netherlands.

Recently, Dutton, (Penguin Random House), began releasing its first batch of mini books. The tiny editions are the size of a cellphone and no thicker than your thumb, with paper as thin as onion skin. They can be read with one hand — the text flows horizontally, and you can flip the pages upward, like swiping a smartphone. Could this book format be in the future for our students? You bet!
