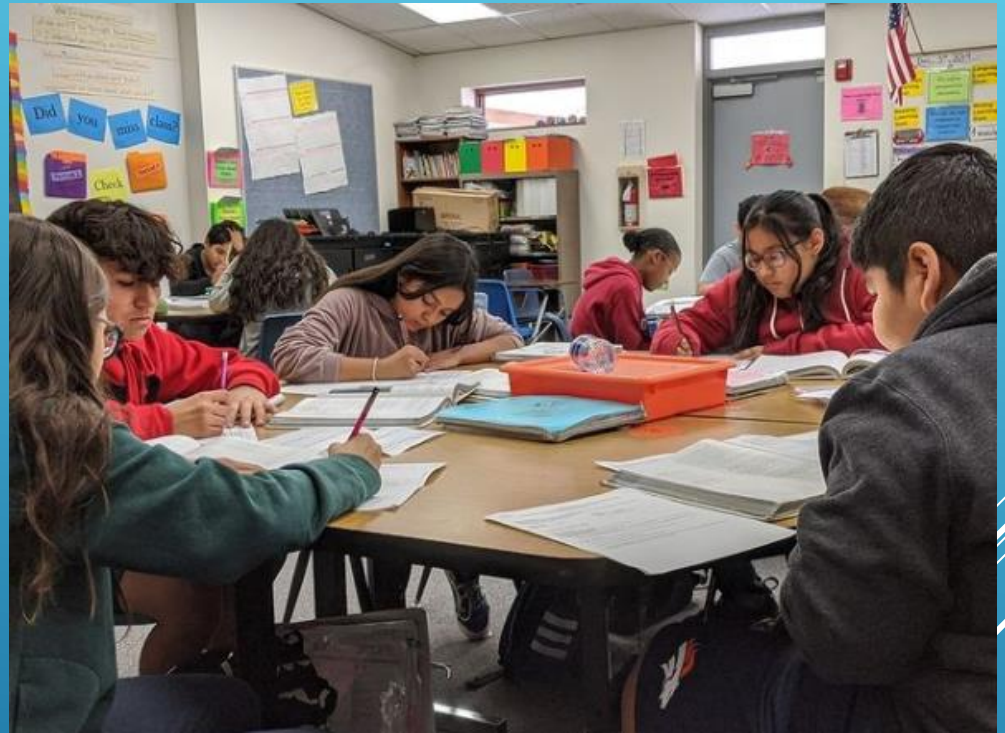


ATTENDANCE
