### Sportsmanship Focus

- Athletes are expected to have a sense of commitment and dedication, team-work, and cooperation which are skills that will be used throughout the athletes life.
- Athletes are expected to have respect for the efforts, abilities, and rights of others.
- Athletes must be aware of the leadership responsibilities in their school and community.

### **Eligibility**

- Grade checks at progress reports, on Friday, April 18th
  - If failing any class, student-athlete must sit out 1 competition
  - Once passing, student can be eligible to return to competitions
  - Weekly checks thereafter through the remainder of the season

#### **Treatment of Officials**

- Athletes and spectators are expected to treat all officials in any sport with respect.
- Parents, let the players play and the officials officiate.
- Athletes who are disrespectful to any official may be suspended or removed from the team.
- Parents who are loud and unruly at any athletic competition may be asked to leave by the official or administrator present.

Students will always be supervised by an adult and should never be in areas such as the locker room without an adult present.
