1. What could a schedule look like at Chandler Online Academy (COA)?

COA Option Breakdown

Scenarios:

Students can be in one of the following categories:

Part Time-Semester: Taking at least one class on your campus, but the rest with COA; all COA classes will be a semester in length.

Full Time-Quarter: Taking all 6 courses online with the option to return to the traditional school site at the quarter.

Full Time-Semester: Taking 3 first semester courses in first quarter and 3 first semester classes in second quarter; return in January

Full Time-Full Year: Taking 3 first semester courses in first quarter and 3 second semester classes in second quarter; staying entire school year

PART TIME-Semester:

Schedule: All requested courses- could be 1 course or 5 courses (all courses should be first semester courses)

5. Are there live lessons in junior high and high school?

No, there are no live lessons, but more interactive lessons.

6. Why do I have an orientation class?

*Chandler Online Academy Student Orientation
Students will have a class in their account called “Chandler Online Academy Student Orientation”. Students will need to watch all the videos in that course before starting their class(es). These videos will show students how to navigate the online classroom, email their teacher, view assignments, read feedback from their teacher, and how to submit assignments and assessments. There will be an assessment at the end of this course that must be passed with an 80% or better. All other courses will have an assignment in the Welcome Folder that requires the student to submit a screenshot of their home screen that verifies the student name and the score that was received on this assessment.*

7. It looks like my student is enrolled in multiple courses for the same period.

Does that matter?

No, periods don't matter. Please ignore this.

8. My student wants to take a dual enrollment course. Why does the course name in the schedule not indicate dual enrollment?

Dual enrollment is an opt in option. Not every student will take the course for dual enrollment so we do not indicate that on the title. Rest assured, your student is

receiving a course taught by a dual enrollment certified teacher and will receive the credit.
