CHOICE



ACHIEVEMENT

Academic achievement is a high priority in the district as evidenced by test scores above the state and national averages. Our students consistently score among the top in the state on college-entrance exams and are top earners of prestigious awards in state and national competitions.

CUSD has also earned a reputation for excellence in athletic achievement winning a variety of state championship trophies and medals in every sport.





DISTRICT WIDE ACHIEVEMENTS



TOP SCHOOLS

During the 2022-23 school year, Auxier Elementary School was re-certified as a Leader In Me Lighthouse School. This is the highest level of achievement recognized through the Leader in Me program. Auxier is one of only nine schools in Arizona and the first in Chandler Unified to achieve the Lighthouse designation. Hartford Sylvia Encinas was named an Arizona Educational Foundation A+ School of Excellence for 2022.

Weinberg Gifted Academy was named a 2022 National Blue Ribbon School. CUSD schools have earned A+ Schools of Excellence or U.S. Blue Ribbon awards 96 times since 1983, more than any other district in the state. Almost all current CUSD schools have been recognized with these designations.

FOCUS ON STUDENTS

Chandler Unified School District introduced Portrait of a Learner in the 2022-2023 school year. Portrait of a Learner supports and guides whole-child and post-graduation success for all students through the teaching of six attributes: adaptability, collaboration, communication, critical thinking, empathy, and global citizen.





PRESTIGIOUS PARTNERS

Chandler Unified School District now has a Girls Flag Football League. Nike and the National Football League's Arizona Cardinals made a generous donation in support of CUSD's girls flag football teams.

LEADING BY EXAMPLE

CUSD was the #1 district in Arizona to raise money for the American Heart Association. The district raised \$128,435 this year (compared to \$98,086 last year). The next closest district raised around \$80,000. Thank you to the 17 schools that participated in this fundraising event. In addition, CUSD staff participated in the district annual United Way fundraiser and raised \$93,575 to benefit our local community.

ACADEMICS

CUSD students and schools earned more than 200 state or national academic awards in 2022. This includes 56 National Merit semifinalists, 28 Capstone Scholars and 8 Flinn Scholarship semifinalists.





ATHLETICS

In 2022 CUSD Athletics shined. All CUSD high schools brought home team state championships or runner-up awards. In total CUSD teams and individuals were recognized more than 80 times in the last year. Basha High brought home its first Varsity Football State Championship in the Open Division in December 2022. In addition, three CUSD coaches were named Athletic Directors of the Year.

FINE ARTS

CUSD students and staff excel in fine arts, earning nearly 100 state or national awards in 2022. This includes titles in marching band, jazz band, dance, and more. Also in 2022, 80 CUSD graduates earned the fine arts diploma seal. Arizona State Seal of Arts Proficiency is awarded to students who have demonstrated high levels of proficiency and commitment to the Arizona Arts Education Standards through personal expression and creative experiences.





STEM

CUSD was top of the class when it came to STEM (Science Technology Engineering Math) awards in 2022. Awards were earned by students and staff in state and national robotics competitions, AZSEF, Cyber Security, Bioscience, Broadcom Masters and the National Science and Engineering Fair. Chandler Unified educates about 3% of the students in Arizona, yet CUSD students took home one third (29%) of the state's award-winning projects at the Arizona Science and Engineering Fair (AzSEF). CUSD students represent 36.8% of the students qualifying for the prestigious International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF).

SUPERINTENDENT

Franklin R. Narducci is CUSD's seventh Superintendent. Mr. Narducci has served as a principal and director in CUSD for 25 years, the last nine years serving as the Assistant Superintendent for Elementary Education. Under his leadership, CUSD's Community Education Department was formed, and schools have received State and National recognitions such as: The National Blue-Ribbon Award; America's Best; and Arizona A+ Schools of Excellence.

Frank is well known for his work in the field of education. He has taught educational leadership and theory courses as an adjunct staff member for Northern Arizona University and is an advocate for Early Childhood Education, having served on the East Maricopa County First Things First Council.



Frank has received numerous recognitions including National Distinguished Principal, Chandler Chamber Administrator of the Year, and was featured in the June 2018 Chandler Lifestyle Magazine as one of the Amazing Men of Chandler. He also received the Si Se Puede Foundation's Cesar E. Chavez Educator of the year Award, First Things First Service Award, and was recognized for his leadership role with the Chandler Downtown Community Partnership and the Chandler Center for the Arts.

GOVERNING BOARD

Our district relies on the vision and stability provided by our governing board. The Chandler Unified School Governing Board, like many elected bodies, contains many diverse opinions and ideas. Individual board members retain their First Amendment rights to free speech; however, personal comments do not represent the official position of the District. Governing board members are elected by the public, serving four-year terms. The board sets all district policies and has final authority over all district business. The public is welcome at governing board business meetings, usually held on the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month (7 p.m.). Study sessions are held as needed.
