It is time to choose your classes for next year! Please register via the Campus Portal of Infinite Campus. Students must log into the Campus Portal and register for courses. Directions for registration are on our website. This worksheet is to prepare students for this online registration and will be collected by counselors when they meet with students one on one.

We hire teachers and create the master schedule based on student requests. Please consider your selections carefully, as we will be unable to accommodate schedule changes after schedules are created.

- Students **must** select classes to fill six (6) periods.
- Students **must** provide at least three (3) alternate choices for electives in case their original choices are unavailable.
- Students registering for Off Campus Release Time (Seminary) must indicate this by filling in one of their electives. This will replace one elective and does not contribute toward graduation requirements. Students should register for Summer School, Zero Hour or Chandler Online Academy to replace this credit.
