Akash Patel, Keynote Speaker

Akash Patel is a Spanish and Mathematics teacher with Dallas Independent School District and the Founder of Happy World Foundation, a non-profit organization that promotes global citizenship education, citizen-to-citizen diplomacy and cross-cultural understanding in schools and communities worldwide. He speaks six languages and has traveled to over 40 countries.

In 2018, Patel was selected from over 30,000 teachers as one of the world’s top 50 educators and shortlisted as a finalist for the \$1 million Global Teacher Prize. He earned his Associate degree of Liberal Studies at Oklahoma City Community College, a Bachelor of Elementary Education from the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma, and a Master degree of Adult and Higher Education from the University of Central Oklahoma.
