

Receiving and Sending Your Scores

Mailed Scores

ACT score reports are **mailed up to 8 weeks** after we receive your test responses. Expect to receive ACT (no writing) score reports 3-8 weeks after the test date and ACT with writing score reports 5-8 weeks after the test date.

Scores on the Web

You can view your score report for free using an ACT web account.

After you receive your paper score report:

- Create an account. Go to **www.actstudent.org** and follow the on-screen directions.
- If you have an account before testing, wait at least 1 week after you receive your paper score report to check for your State or District testing scores.

You can also use your ACT web account to access other services, such as requesting and paying for Additional Score Reports (ASRs) or registering to retake the test on a future National test date.

Official ACT Score Reports

Your State or District testing scores will be reported as follows:

- **Student**—Your paper report will be mailed to the address you entered in your non-test information. If you provide an inaccurate address, no report will be mailed.
- **High School**—A report will be mailed to the Director of Counseling at your high school.
- **College**—Each college and national scholarship agency will receive a report, if you enter a valid ACT code number when completing non-test information. Each college selects the frequency of reporting—at least every two weeks.
- **State or District Education Agency**—Your state or district education agency will receive your scores, even if you choose not to report them to any colleges.

Test Location

State or District testing scores are indicated as “State” under “Test Location” on reports.

No Reporting of Accommodations or Supports

ACT does not report any information about accommodations or English learner supports provided.

Non-College Reportable Accommodations

ACT will not report scores earned with non-college reportable accommodations to colleges, scholarship agencies, or any other entities. These scores are for state or district assessment purposes only.

One Test Date per Report

ACT score reports include only the results for the current test date. Because you direct the reporting of your scores, results from previous test dates are not included.

State or District Testing Record

Because your record is used to document participation in State or District testing, you may **not** direct us to remove your testing record from our files.

Additional Score Reports (ASRs)

When you complete your non-test information, you may designate four colleges or scholarship agencies to receive your score report at no cost to you.

To request and pay for Additional Score Reports for **any** recipient (e.g., high school, college):

- Create or sign in to your ACT web account at **www.actstudent.org** and follow the on-screen instructions to request an ASR.
