

POEM

Compose a poem about a character or theme in the story, and explain the meaning of your poem.

Your poem must have a minimum of 12 lines.

Must use a minimum of two types of figurative language (simile, metaphor, personification, onomatopoeia, hyperbole, idiom, or alliteration).

Your poem should be hand-written.

CHARACTER HEAD

Choose a main character from your story and create a model of your character's head.

Use a fake pumpkin to create your character's head. It may be painted or paper machéd. You may use various craft items for hair, features, or accessories.

Write a personal description from the character's point of view, describing himself or herself (use first person).

Description must be typed and a minimum of six sentences.

COLLAGE

Completely covered paper with pictures related to characters and events from your book.

At least: 11" x 14"

Use magazines, newspapers, stickers, scrapbook material, or clipart.

Student must be able to explain how each picture relates to the book.

A minimum of <u>20 pictures</u> must be used in your collage.
