TRAVEL BROCHURE

Design a travel brochure that would inform people about the main setting of the story.

Brochure must include ALL of the following:

- heading
- map
- things to do
- interesting facts
- historical information

Include at least 2 hand drawn pictures in your brochure.

Brochure must be handmade by the student.

BOARD GAME

Create a game that reflects events, characters, and setting from the book.

IE: Monopoly, Sorry, Candy Land

Include ALL of the following:

- board game with title
- game pieces
- instructions for playing the game
- object of the game/how to win

Board game must relate to the book; and it must be visually appealing and colorful.

Game must be handmade by the student.

TELEVISION

Create a television using a box. Decorate the box to resemble an actual television.

TV's should include scenes from the book. A minimum of 5 scenes must be included. Scenes will have appropriate illustrations (in sequence) to match the main events in your book.

Student must be able to explain each scene as you present the events.

Television must be handmade by student; including hand drawn pictures in color.
