Nightly:

Each week your child will complete a homework packet which will be emailed to you on Friday. They will not be due until the following Friday. This will consist of either a writing or reading skill.

Quarterly:

Students will have quarterly AR reading goals and book project assignments. Check purple HOME folders for information and dates.

Grading

- All 4th graders keep their graded work in binders. If at any time you would like to see your child's graded work, please let me know and I'll send the binder home. Keep ALL papers inside the binder until they are sent home at the end of each quarter.
