Math (next two weeks): ade Math Classes— Studer

5th Grade Math Classes— Students will be working with properties and multiplying multi-digit numbers.

Brown's Math Class— The students began learning how to add, subtract, multiply, and divide decimals. They will be testing on it early next week and then will be multiplying and dividing fractions and mixed numbers.

Reading:

The students have been learning the 5th grade Daily 5 routines/ expectations. The next couple weeks, we will begin with our rotations where students will work on their Daily 5 menus while I work with small groups. In our rotations, we will be focusing on citing evidence and finding the main idea and details of a passage.

Writing:

The students created a Lifeline (timeline of their life) and began writing a personal narrative. The next couple weeks, we will focus on narrowing in on a single event and adding more details.
