- Reading 20 minutes per night is recommended

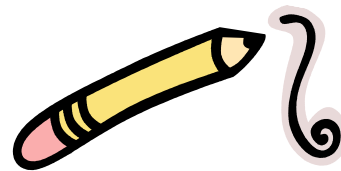

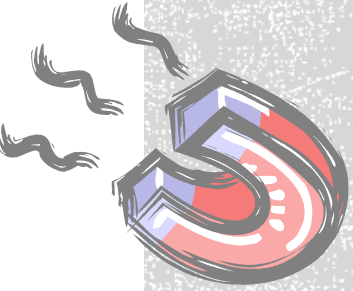

- Studying is required prior to tests ie. Spelling, vocabulary, comprehension, etc.



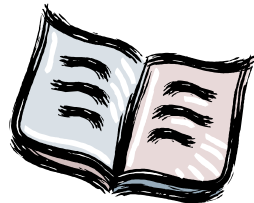
# Differentiated INSTRUCTION

- To maximize student success and to ensure that gaps in learning do not occur, instruction is differentiated for each child.
- Students are continually assessed to ensure proper placement.
- Students who demonstrate an advanced level of concept mastery in Mathematics and/or English Language Arts may be moved to an accelerated course during their scheduled subject time. We will be offering 2 advanced reading sections as well as 2 advanced math sections.
- A child that is placed in an accelerated course one year, does not mean he/she will be placed in an accelerated course the following year.
- We will continue to implement Gifted Clustering.



# GRADING

- 2 weekly grades in core subject areas will be given.
- Graded work will come home each week
- Progress reports and report cards will be available through the parent portal on Infinite Campus
- If your child is not progressing as expected, you will be contacted.
