Hoop Scholarship Criteria

- Attending high school, 9th, 10th, or 11th grade
- Enrolled in a federal or state Tribal Nation
- Minimum high school GPA-2.0

How it works:

- Year-round program = 12 college credits a year
 - Summer (2 classes)
 - fall (1 class)
 - spring (1 class)
- New students begin in the summer session
 - Summer 2023: May 30 - June 29
- Fall and Spring: attend classes on Saturday mornings
- All classes are in-person
- Attend workshops each semester
