


Volunteer Guidelines


Art Masterpiece What a Lesson Should Look Like


- Meet the Artist: 5 min. max
- Discussion of the artwork: 10 min. max
- Process: 40-60 minutes
- Music: Introduce music as students are working
- Cleanup
- Students that finish early
- Discipline
- Remind students when 15, 10, 5 minutes work time is remaining

Tips for keeping students engaged

- Keep the artist bio short. 5 10 minutes. Otherwise you might lose your audience. Students are eager to get started.
- Ask open-ended questions that begin with "Why do you think...",
 "How..." to encourage interaction
- Consider a location change (Bio/Lesson on floor, desk for project)
- Relate the artist or the work to their own lives as much as possible.
 For example, find something that the artist did when they were the students age.





Art Masterpiece brings art into your child's classroom, six times throughout the school year!

Each time we visit, we will have a carefully selected artist to discuss, an example of their work and a hands on project. This usually takes between 60-90 minutes. We make a concentrated effort to expose your child to a diverse range of artists that are considered masters in their own style. Musical composers and specific musical pieces will link the artist to the music of that era, or will share the same theme of the artwork being studied. It will be played during this time to more fully enhance their art experience.

Students will keep their artwork in the classroom, in a portfolio. In the Spring, they will select their best work for display at the school wide Arts Show.


